This report covers the highlights of the May 2nd, 2018 DPAC meeting.

Sentinel Multicultural Lunch (Hollise brown)

This is the main fundraiser of the year for Sentinel where around \$7,500 is raised (with between 2,000 - 3,500 servings). A variety of countries are represented. Compostable plates are used and parents cook or donate food. Food Safe guidelines are adhered to and tickets are sold for \$1.00 per food item.

DPAC

o DPAC Rep. names should be forwarded to Lesley Miller. General meeting will be on June 6th, 2018. There has been some fine tuning of the DPAC bylaws (last update June 1996).

Finance and Facilities

- o District awarded \$3.6 million for building envelope and HVAC system at Irwin Park
- o Sentinel gym project is ongoing (sprung structure containing two new gym spaces and academy offices to be ready for the start of next school year).

School Trustee Report (Nicola Brown):

- Summer Learning registration opened May 1st. Classes will be held in the morning at West Vancouver Secondary and include full credit courses, preview courses, upgrade courses and Math Head Start.
- o Animation Academy has been very successful this year. It is offered for Grade 11 and 12 students in collaboration with the Capilano University Film Studies program.
- o BC School Trustees Association AGM Carolyn Broady on the Board of Directors again.

Associate Superintendent Report (Sean Nosek):

- o Teacher Recruitment taking place at local education career fairs
- o Low retirement numbers this year and overall numbers more stable
- o Fully staffed for French Immersion teachers
- o Enrolment:
 - o Approx. 7,332 students enrolled for next year
 - Only West Vancouver Secondary is currently open for additional students as the high school level
- o Grad Programs:
 - o Grade 10 new curriculum implementation 2018-2019
 - o Grade 11-12 implementation is 2019-2020
 - o Career courses are changing to include Career Life Education, Career Life Connection and Capstone
 - o Focus on self-assessment for Grade 8 and 9
 - o New numeracy assessment will be completed in June
- o VOIP:
 - Voice Over Internet Protocol replacing the aging telephone system (Mitel Business VOIP selected) with savings of \$5,300/ month in phone bills
 - o District's existing infrastructure and data network can be used
 - Elementary Schools, Rockridge and Facilities transitioned to VOIP this year, the rest of District will be starting later this year

DPAC Guest Speaker

o Lynne Tomlinson who discussed Aboriginal Education in the District.
