AP Courses/Exams

- Because you are taking an AP course you have the opportunity to write the corresponding AP Exam but you must be taking the course.
- AP Exams take place in the first 2 weeks of May (May 4th-May 15th)

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- Your choice (except for AP Art, AP Calc)
 - AP exam marks do not impact your school mark and your school mark does not impact your AP exam mark
 - AP exam marks are not available until July

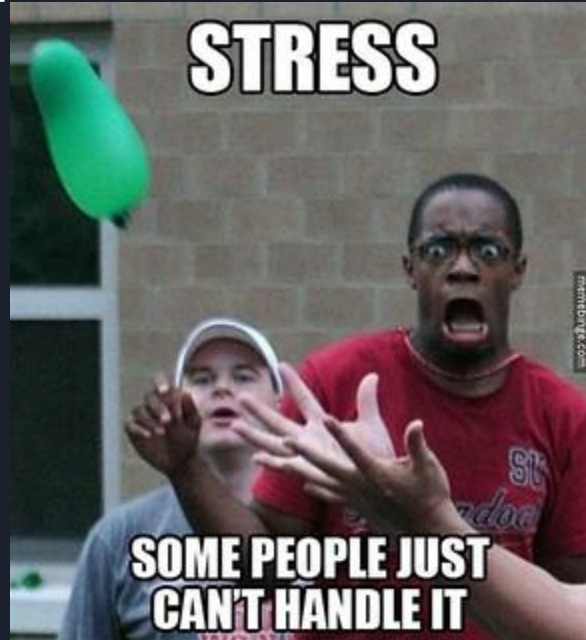


Reasons to take the Exam

- Finish the challenge
- Score of 4 or 5 can move into 2nd year courses
- Good preparation for university exams
- No risk


Reasons not to take Exam

Process

- Register for class on AP system (similar to Google Classroom) with teacher code. You must have an AP account to do this.
- Choose **Register for Exam**
