Guest speaker: A Chat to Support Gender Diversity in Our Community with Lucas Wilson, a public health educator and coordinator.

Lucas Wilson is a public health educator and coordinator working in the field of transgender health. Lucas's background is in youth work and he has worked extensively with the Vancouver School Board and other school districts in the Greater Vancouver Area to support inclusive school policy and transition plans for students. More recently, Lucas has worked in numerous roles directly supporting trans, gender diverse and Two Spirit people of all ages, particularly in the context of gender affirming healthcare access. He is also a MPH (Master of Public Health) candidate at Simon Fraser University and hopes to utilize his education in support of accessible and capable systems of care for underserved populations.

Supporting Trans, Gender-Diverse and Two Spirit Youth and Young Adults: When schools and communities are gender inclusive all youth benefit. This presentation will:

- Provide foundational knowledge about gender diversity
- Identify the needs of trans, gender-diverse and Two Spirit youth in a school/community setting
- Discuss protective factors and frameworks to enhance the safety and belonging of all youth
