### Our School

Rockridge Secondary School is a co-ed grade 8-12 public high school founded in 1996 in the municipality of West Vancouver. Rockridge is an authorized International Baccalaureate World School where all students in Grades 8-10 participate in the IB Middle Years Programme. Rockridge also offers a range of Advanced Placement (AP) courses to Grade 11 and 12 students to get a head start in their post-secondary studies. The total enrollment this year is 831 students. Our students travel daily from islands, coastal inlets, the sea to-sky corridor, North Vancouver and West Vancouver. The current graduating class of 171 students, comprises a diverse range of cultures, socioeconomic status, parental education backgrounds and career aspirations. Adding to our student diversity are our international students which make up approximately 9% of our total student population.

Our students are very mobile when it comes to traveling outside the province for post-secondary studies compared to other BC public schools. Approximately 40% of our students leave the province to study, with about 7-8% going international. Our enrollment is down this year due to reduced numbers of international students and demographics of the school catchment. As a result students have fewer course choices.

### Mission Statement

Rockridge Secondary School strives to graduate responsible and creative global citizens in a respectful and diverse environment where relevant learning fosters excellence in personal achievement, compassion, curiosity, and critical thinking.

### The School Calendar

March, 2020 we moved to providing virtual learning for all our students. This continued until the end of June, 2020. Students received final marks based on work completed during the entire 2019/20 school year. In September 2020,

we moved from a linear school timetable to a quarterly system to provide more flexibility during the pandemic. In the fall of 2021 we changed the time table again to a semester system. Students typically take four courses per semester with some of our career and fine arts courses being offered over the entire year. This year (2022/23), we have continued on a semester based timetable.

Semester 1: Sep.06 - Jan.31  
Semester 2: Feb.01 - Jun.26

Final grades for subjects taken should be available one week after the completion of the semester. Midterm grades will be posted Nov. 17th and Apr. 27th

This year all classes are scheduled to be held in person. Classes meet four times per week for between 80 to 115 minutes per day. Students also have the opportunity to work independently or collaboratively with the support of their teachers on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons for 95 minutes.

### Graduation Requirements

80 credits including English Language Arts 10-12, Math 10 and 11 or 12, Science 10 and 11 or 12, Social Studies 10 and 12, PE 10, one Fine Arts or Applied Skills 10-12, Careers 10 and 12, and 30 hours of experiential learning are required for the BC Dogwood Diploma. Students must take a minimum of three other Grade 12 courses in addition to English or English First Peoples 12 and are also required to take formal provincial graduation numeracy and literacy assessments.

### Marking System

Rockridge uses an unweighted 100-point system. The following is a list of British Columbia Ministry of Education authorized final letter grades for all courses listed on report cards and transcripts. The GPA equivalent, on a 4.0 scale, is listed for the purpose of US university information only:

### Honour Roll / Awards

Honour Roll is achieved with a GPA of 79.5 to 85.4. Honours with Distinction is achieved with a GPA of 85.5 to 100. Calculations are based on courses taken within the West Vancouver School District and on a student's best marks on 6 of 8 Grade 12 courses taken in their final year. No failing or incomplete marks are allowed; only courses with letter grades assigned are eligible to be included (see the Rockridge website for further details). The Prestige Award is given to two Rockridge students in each grade who have shown outstanding excellence in academics, fine arts or sports and leadership. The Principal's Award is given to two Rockridge students in each grade who have shown leadership and community spirit in clubs or activities in and outside of the school.

### Enriched Courses 2022/23

Rockridge offered fewer enriched programs over the last two years due to Covid-19 and resulting changes in the time table. When students have an AP course in semester 2, they may be expected to attend seminars during semester one, in addition to their regular course load. The opposite is true if they have an AP in the first semester. Several AP courses overlap so students need to pick and choose which AP courses they take. Because of the reduced AP offering, grade 12 students are prioritized. AP Courses are unweighted.

Rockridge offered few district academy programs last year as a result to Covid-19. This year programs include: Baseball, Basketball, Carpentry, Engineering, Environmental Science, Fashion Industry, Fencing, Field Hockey, First Aid Swim Training, Honour Choir, Outdoor Recreation, Rugby, Soccer, Tennis, Robotics, Yoga Teacher Training, Young Entrepreneurs and Leadership, Volleyball.

During the pandemic there have been limited opportunities for our students to volunteer for clubs and community activities last year. Rockridge graduates attend university and post-secondary programs at a rate of approximately 85% (within one year of graduation), compared to a provincial rate of 57%.
