### **HEADING BACK TO LINEAR FOR 2023-24**

Next year we will be in a <u>linear timetable system</u> which means that all students will have 8 classes in their timetable that run all year. 4 classes on each day. Day 1 classes on one day and then Day 2 classes the following day.

Academies will take place either in the morning before school, during 1-4 and 2-4 (the afternoon periods) or after school. Your academy will let you know the schedule details.

There will be 50 mins of Flexible instructional time (FIT).

FIT will take place on **Mondays and Thursdays from 10:55 - 11:45am** and is replacing Block 5. Lunch and Period 4 will begin at the same time each day.

Staff collaboration will take place 11 times next year. Collaboration days always fall on a Thursday from 8:30 to 9:25. 4 classes will follow with lunch and period 4 beginning at the usual time.
