STUDENT VERIFICATION & EMERGENCY RELEASE FORMS

These forms were sent home with your child at the beginning of last week. Many thanks to the hundreds we have already received. If your child has not returned these yet, please return to the office as soon as possible so that we can complete our Emergency Preparedness Plan per school district requirements.

This online verification and consent form requires a parent login and must be submitted for each student at the start of each school year. We ask that it is submitted ONLY ONCE PER STUDENT in September, as the upload gets very onerous with multiple submissions. For later changes, please inform the office.

- If you previously created an account to complete the 22/23 form, the account is the same.
- If you have forgotten your password, you can follow the instructions to reset it.
- Once logged in, you will have the option to either update a P+P form created last year or start a new one.
- Without a completed consent form, students will not be permitted to attend field trips, join school teams or have their photos included in the yearbook. Permissions expire on August 31 each year.

Student Bus Transportation - IMPORTANT

Each student must register (by completing the online registration request form:

https://westvancouverschools.ca/transportation-form/ to reserve a seat on the bus.

Our District has reserved buses based on the number of registered students, and there are more students arriving to board our buses than are registered. With this message going out last week there has been an improvement, but we are not there yet. Be sure to submit the online registration form via the link above, and that you have received confirmation from Transportation SD45.

MYED BC Parent Portal
