A MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

I wanted to highlight a few special points regarding next week before we head into our September Professional Development Day tomorrow.

- **#1.** There is no school for students tomorrow. Our staff, however, will be busy learning with our professional learning networks here at the Rock.
- **#2.** Clubs Day is coming during FIT on Monday, Sept 25. All students will be circulating through the East and West wings to learn about club opportunities and sign up for the year ahead. Students in grade 8-10 will have a short presentation from their period 1-3 teacher about the benefits of being part of a club which include *finding your people* and, in some cases, gaining service hours.
- **#3**. Thursday is our first Collaboration Day Schedule. We have included the schedule for Thursday below for your convenience. During collaboration time, the school is open, and students are encouraged to attend, but it is not mandatory (attendance will not be taken during this time). Students may use this time to complete assignments and other incomplete work. Students who are in attendance during collaboration time will be stationed in the cafeteria where we will have staff supervising. For students planning to work from home, they are reminded to arrive on time for their first block of the day which

begins at 9:30 am. Please note, we have not been able to schedule a later bus run for students for the Collaboration Day but will continue to explore this option moving forward.

This online verification and consent form requires a parent login and must be submitted for each student at the start of each school year. We ask that it is submitted ONLY ONCE PER STUDENT in September, as the upload gets very onerous with multiple submissions. For later changes, please inform the office.

- If you previously created an account to complete the 22/23 form, the account is the same.
- If you have forgotten your password, you can follow the instructions to reset it.
- Once logged in, you will have the option to either update a P+P form created last year or start a new one.
- Without a completed consent form, students will not be permitted to attend field trips, join school teams or have their photos included in the yearbook. Permissions expire on August 31 each year.

Student Bus Transportation - IMPORTANT

Each student must register (by completing the online registration request form: https://westvancouverschools.ca/transportation-form/ to reserve a seat on the bus.

Our District has reserved buses based on the number of registered students, and there are more students arriving to board our buses than are registered. With this message going out last week there has been an improvement, but we are not there yet. Be sure to submit the online registration form via the link above, and that you have received confirmation from Transportation SD45.
