Student Verification & Emergency Release Forms - Overdue

These forms were sent home with your child at the beginning of the school year. As these forms are necessary to complete the Emergency Preparedness Plan per school district requirements, we appreciate your adherence, completion and return of these forms.

Online Policies & Procedures Form - Overdue 2023-2024-https://westvancouverschools.ca/policies-and-procedures-form/

This online verification and consent form requires a parent login and must be submitted for each student at the start of each school year. We ask that it is submitted ONLY ONCE PER STUDENT, as the upload gets very onerous with multiple submissions. Again, we are only at **60%** and we need to be at **100%.** For later changes, please inform the office.

- If you previously created an account to complete the 22/23 form, the account is the same.
- If you have forgotten your password, you can follow the instructions to reset it.
- Once logged in, you will have the option to either update a P+P form created last year or start a new one
- Without a completed consent form, students will not be permitted to attend field trips, join school teams or have their photos included in the yearbook. Permissions expire on August 31 each year.
