# THIS WEEK'S MYP MOMENT

Time for another Personal Project update! With the end of the year fast approaching, students have been working on completing a draft of their Personal Project Report. This means that students should have addressed the following criterions:

- Criterion A: Planning
  - State a learning goal, as well as a product goal.
  - Develop success criteria that will be used to evaluate the product.
  - Create a detailed plan to ensure that all components of the learning and product goals can be successfully completed in a timely manner.
- Criterion B: Applying Skills
  - Identify specific Approaches to Learning Skills (i.e. Communication, Social, Selfmanagement, Research, Thinking) that will be necessary to achieve the learning and product goals.

Students will complete the remaining criterion (C: Reflecting) after Winter Break, once they have actually created their product (if they haven't already done so). So, over the holiday season, please feel free to ask your Grade 10 learner about how their product goal is going, as they may need an extra reminder to "wrap things up" in regard to the product-creation process!

For an extra bit of motivation and inspiration, students can look forward to a visit from Mr. Kolkea over the next week or so. Mr. Kolkea will be spending time with each CLE class to share his enthusiasm about the Personal Project, as well as next year's Exhibition on February 8th. It's just a few months away now, and we are absolutely brimming with eager anticipation!

#### WEATHER CLOSURES AND PROCEDURES

West Vancouver Schools endeavours to keep schools open on regular instructional days, including those with accumulating snowfall (Weather Closures and Procedures). Any decision to close schools will be made by the Superintendent and will be based on the safety of students and staff. We aim to communicate any decision to close schools by 6:00 am via the district and school websites as well as through social media and local news.

#### **ATTENDANCE - Notifying the Office and Extended Absences**

If you know your student will not be in attendance for all, or part of a school day, we ask that you please let our office know in advance - <u>rockridge@wvschools.ca</u> Please include your child's first and last name in your email.

Daily attendance is critical to ensure student success here at Rockridge. <u>We do not recommend</u> absences during the school term but realize they may be unavoidable. Please keep in mind that

certain classroom activities and assessments may not be able to be made up if missed.

Please notify the school a minimum of one week in advance using this <u>form</u> for an extended absence. Teachers are not required to provide extra classes, make-up tests or specific work to be completed.
