# THIS WEEK'S MYP MOMENT

Want to know what the teachers were up to during today's collaboration time? We were busy updating our scope and sequence documents to ensure that our units address the *BC Curriculum Curricular Competencies* and the **MYP Subject-Group Objectives**. Both the competencies and objectives reflect the skills, strategies and processes that students will develop over time. Here are a few examples of what this alignment looks like:

- Mathematics: MYP Criterion A is <u>Knowing and Understanding</u>, which corresponds to *Understanding and Solving* in the BC Curriculum.
- Language and Literature (English): MYP Criterion B is **Organizing**, which corresponds to *Creating and Communicating* in the BC Curriculum.
- Arts: MYP Criterion C is <u>Creating/Performing</u>, which corresponds to *Creating* and *Communicating* in the BC Curriculum.
- Design: MYP Criterion D is **Evaluating**, which corresponds to *Sharing* in the BC Curriculum.

Both the BC Curriculum and the MYP promote "a concept-based approach to learning [...] to foster deeper, more transferable learning". At Rockridge, we hope that our units will allow students to accomplish this through relevant and engaging learning experiences. We look forward to sharing more information about our units in future E-Bulletins. Stay tuned!
