A MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL & THIS WEEK'S MYP MOMENT

This is the week parents! Tomorrow you'll be able to access the learning update(s) (formerly known as report cards) for the Rockridge student(s) in your household. Here are some helpful reminders (and RE-reminders!) as you navigate them:

1) What the Levels Mean in Grades 8 - 10

The MYP Levels are aligned with the new BC Proficiency Scale. So, if you see a Level of 4 for a specific criterion, it does NOT mean that your student received a 4 out of 8. It means the following:

Emerging	Developing	Proficient	Extending
Levels 1 - 2	Levels 3 - 4	Levels 5 - 6	Levels 7 - 8
Demonstrates an initial understanding of the expected learning.	Demonstrates a partial understanding of the expected learning.	Demonstrates a complete understanding of the expected learning.	Demonstrates a sophisticated understanding of the expected learning.

A passing level in a course is considered a 2.

If a 1 or an IE (insufficient evidence) is present, students will be given a supportive action plan to help get them back on track in the remainder of the course. You will receive this from the teacher.

2) In Grades 8-10 Not All Criterion Categories May Be Assessed in a Course at This Time

With the linear system, the pacing is more spread out, so courses may not have had enough time to assess all four criteria for their subject area. So, if you see a blank, *don't panic!* (ALL subject areas will have ALL FOUR criterions assessed by Learning Update 2.)

3) Learning Takes Time

Perhaps your student isn't content with the levels they are receiving at this time. Remind them that growing and learning takes time. They will not remain at these levels throughout the year if they're willing to reflect on what has been and make some plans to lean into the spaces that need attention.

4) Look for the Teacher Comments not the IB Generated Comments

Lastly, we're going to encourage you to ignore the generic IB comments that are generated based on levels and instead look to the specifics from your teacher's comment (it will be indicated where it begins). The comments that are auto generated from IB for the MYP program are in the lengthy process of being updated on a global scale, and currently, the language does not align with where BC Assessment is moving. So, ignore them! Look at the teacher's comment first. They know and can give the best feedback on your student.

We hope these reminders are helpful to you as you navigate through the first Learning Updates of the year for our MYP students!

For senior students in Grades 11 & 12, the percentages are aligned with the new proficiency scale but are still reported as a letter grade and percentage. You will also notice a page in the report card that outlines the percentage ranges as well as information on the proficiencies and what they mean. Teachers may have used the proficiency language to explain how students are progressing in their learning.
