VIRTUAL PARENT-TEACHER INTERVIEWS

We are once again using an online Parent-Teacher Interview scheduling program (http://rss.schoolappointments.com). Access to the system opens at 6:00 pm on Thursday,

January 11 and will close at 10:00pm on Monday, January 22. You will be able to create an account, enter your children and then schedule interview times for you to meet with their teachers virtually. Please review these instructions to set up your account and book appointments

Appointment scheduling will run in five-minute intervals. It is advisable to schedule your appointments with one five-minute block in between, to allow yourself time and not be rushed. There is a maximum of three appointments per student up until January 18, then you will be able to book additional spots pending availability. Due to a limited number of timeslots, please prioritize your teacher selections accordingly. There is not an option for call backs this year.

The system is very easy to use, and it should take only a few minutes to set up your account, add your children and schedule your appointments. To get started, click on the "REGISTER" tab. GRADE 8 SKI TRIP TO WHISTLER is now open for registration-Limited to 43 students so sign up early.

All forms and information can be found on the ski trip Google classroom - pa6vn3s.

- It is a one-day trip on February 14, 2024 leaving Rockridge at 6:45am and returning at 5:15pm. Students will be with Whistler ski or snowboard instructors all day in the Whistler ski school program. There are 6 levels available for students that have never skied or snowboarded before, up to expert riders. It is also an excellent opportunity for skiers to try snowboarding for the first time or vice versa as rentals are included in the cost.

FAST is a young lifeguard education program that allows students to develop the essential skills to be successful and confident lifeguards. At the completion of the FAST program students will have obtained all of the required certification prerequisites necessary to enroll in the National Lifeguard Course, which students can take independently when they are 15 years of age or older. Completion of the National Lifeguard Course is the final credential necessary to qualify an individual to work as a lifeguard.

In addition to developing strong first aid skills, the FAST program also focuses on providing students with a practical foundation in resistance and cardiovascular training, swimming, stroke-development and leadership.
