One of the lenses students of all grades use to set goals within our school is with the Approaches to Learning skills. They are the skills that emphasize 'learning how to learn'. They include:

- Thinking Skills
- Self-Management Skills
- Social Skills
- Communication Skills
- Research Skills

What are the ATL skills your students have room for growth in Term 3? As a family community, what are some clear, attainable goals you can set together to help the students in your household be their best both at school and at home?

In fact, the teaching staff this morning are taking time during collaboration to revisit the ATL skills and look at ways we can incorporate these skills more clearly for our students in our practice and our assessments! This way, students can more clearly name the aspects of the skills they do well already and give more time to the skills they are continuing to develop.

Congrats to the Rockridge Physics Olympics team that finished 3rd overall out of 78 teams from across the province. We had over 20 students contribute to the 3rd place finish.

In addition to the third place finish (tied for our best ever overall finish), Rockridge outright won its first event ever (Cool It Down). In the event students had to design a mechanism to cool down a copper plate over a period of one minute. Rockridge was able to cool the plate over 10 degrees, besting the next best team by 4 degrees!

This online verification and consent form requires a parent login and must be completed for all students each year. If a parent previously created an account to complete the 21/22 form, the account is the same. If you have forgotten your password, you can follow the instructions to reset it. Once logged in, parents have the option to either update a P+P form created last year or start a new one. Please be aware that a new P+P consent form MUST be completed for each student, each school year. Permissions expire on August 31 each year. The form includes consent for the following:
