A great day on Saturday at the Ultimate Tournament, winning 2 games out of 3.



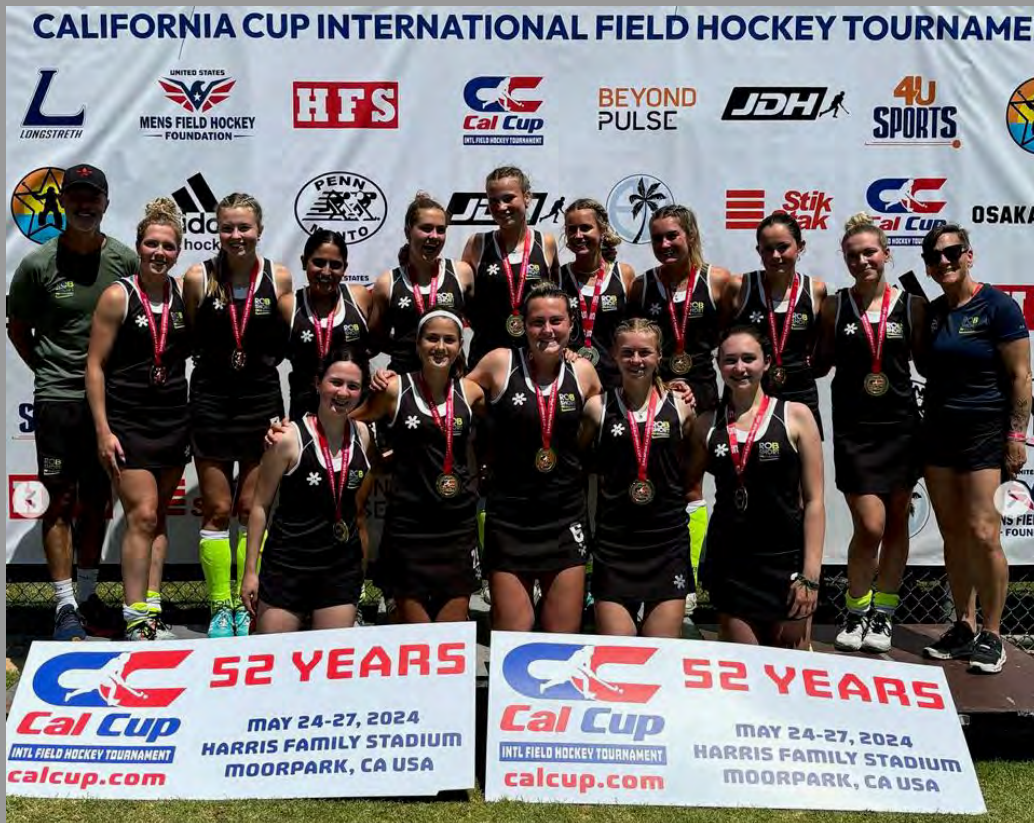
Grade 10 First Peoples students flexed their creative muscles this past week, creating a Lego art installation inspired by our wonderful teacher librarian Nicole Reid

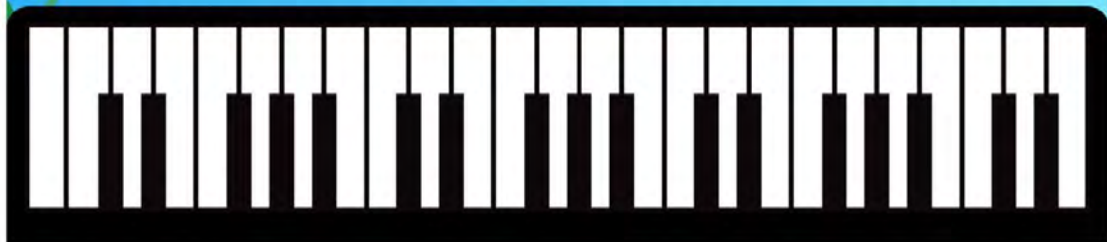

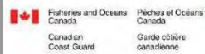
