A MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Live on location from Camp Summit I wanted to share some news about the great trip that is underway with the Class of 2029. I was able to visit Camp Summit after our cross country race yesterday to spend the night and morning with our Ravens. Before heading back to The Rock I took a few minutes and borrowed the Wi-Fi here at camp that our students are not able to access. While I appreciate the skills our students have with technology, being unplugged here at camp has been refreshing for everyone. In case you are unfamiliar with this 8X annual tradition, our grade eights are spending three days and two nights in the remote wilderness of Squamish. This has been a great chance for students to try new activities, connect to nature, make some new friends and work with a variety of Rockridge staff who love coming to support this experience. As an added bonus, our leadership and mentorship students from grade 10 to 12 are helping to staff events here at Camp Summit. Not surprisingly, the official camp staff here are skilled fun leaders that are great role models and facilitators for our students. As we move

through the year and toward the end of June, we will no doubt be highlighting our class of 2025 and their accomplishments towards graduation. For our youngest Ravens they are making memories that I hope will carry through to that moment when they are crossing the stage to graduate in 2029.

My final closing remark is simply a shout out to my amazing Rockridge staff for their support here at camp and at school leading up to and during Camp Summit 2024. With Mr. Baker leading the way we have all been able to take on a role to support another special experience for students at The Rock.

MADD Canada Presentation - Oct 17th for ALL Grade 11 & 12 students

On Thursday, Oct 17, Rockridge will host MADD Canada as their trained facilitators will present their new film: *One Last Dance*. The film's fictional story illustrates the tragic consequences of driving while impaired by alcohol and/or drugs. Throughout the film, students are shown times when the tragedy could have been prevented by making different choices. This *School Program* is proven-effective at encouraging responsible decision-making among youth – both immediately after the presentation and longer term. In the 2022-2023 evaluation survey among participating students, 92% said the program makes them want to make the right decision when it comes to impaired driving and 82% said that they were likely to make a plan for getting home safely when going out with friends. The majority of students felt that consuming cannabis would cause one to drive "a lot worse" with 86% saying this after the presentation and 91% 3-months post presentation. Furthermore, three months after the presentation, half of respondents were more likely to think that cannabis use has a negative effect on the ability to drive.

<u>Course Registration and Fees</u>- Students are joining course sections on their MY AP account, giving them access to a number of supporting materials for the course. The week of October 1st Course and Exam fees will be attached to your School Cash Online account. Fee payments for these courses are due November 1st so the school can accurately complete our exam order.

Exam News New for 2025; all AP exams in courses Rockridge offers will be digital using Bluebook secure technology. Students will complete Multiple Choice sections digitally while completing the Free Response using a computer coupled with a paper/pencil exam booklet. Students will have the opportunity to write a practice exam with their teacher in the weeks leading up to the exam to familiarize themselves.

Online Policies & Procedures Form 2024-2025 - Now at 63% of online consent forms completed!

Please complete this requirement this week and avoid an email from the principal next week. This online verification and consent form requires a parent login and must be submitted for each student at the start of each school year. We ask that it is submitted ONLY ONCE PER STUDENT in September, as the upload gets very onerous with multiple submissions. For later changes, please inform the office.

- If you previously created an account to complete the 22/23 form, the account is the same.
- If you have forgotten your password, you can follow the instructions to reset it.
- Once logged in, you will have the option to either update a P+P form created last year or start a new one.
- Without a completed consent form, students will not be permitted to attend field trips, join school teams or have their photos included in the yearbook. Permissions expire on August 31 each year.

School Drop Off/Pick Up Safety

As you are probably aware, there can be heavy traffic around our school site at opening and dismissal times. It is difficult for vehicles to enter and exit our school parking areas as well as the Caulfeild Mall. The passage of emergency vehicles would be impeded which is of considerable concern. Please consider carpooling, dropping off and picking up your children at a predetermined location away from the school property, and encouraging active transportation (biking, walking). Another helpful action, if possible, for those that have to drive is dropping off your child early. An 8:00 AM arrival is always a great plan and chance to hang in the cafeteria, get some work done at a hallway workstation, or connect with a teacher.

Please note that designated visitor parking spaces at the front of the school are a 'no parking' zone in the morning and after school. The driveway in front of the school entrance is a NO STOPPING zone. All numbered parking spaces are designated for individual staff members. Please do not park in these spaces at any time during school hours.
