A MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

In preparation for the posting of Informal Reports next week, I wanted to check in with families regarding their MyEd access. Next Thursday, October 24 Informal Reports will be published in MyEd. Students, parents and guardians can view these reports in the MyEd portal, and should now be familiar with using their login credentials to access their child's schedule and reports. If you have not yet done so, now is the time to make sure you can access your account so you can review your child's progress next week.

Informal Reports do not contain letter grades or percentages. These reports provide parents with updates on their child's engagement in each class. They may cover aspects such as attendance, participation, assignment completion, preparedness, work habits, and behavior. We know our students can be effective communicators, but they do not always express what and how they are learning to their

family. Next week, these reports will be a great conversation starter for families to check in on the first two months of 2024-25. As always, I encourage you to review your child's Google Classroom with them and ask them about materials that are posted, assignments that are *handed in*, and those that are *missing*.

Every year our school district hosts hundreds of post secondary institutions. Students experienced the voting process on October 15th by casting ballots for the official candidates in the West Vancouver - Sunshine Coast - Sea to Sky riding running in the 2024 Provincial Election. Students learned about the voting process and our electoral system in Social Studies classes, and researched party platforms and their local candidates to see which party best aligned with their values. Studies show that students who are empowered by simulations of the voting process are much more likely to vote as adults!

Special thanks to all the student volunteers from the Model United Nations Club who smoothly ran the polls and counted up the ballots, and the staff who helped make this event happen (Ms.Selzer, Mr. Lam, Ms Kashani, Mrs Rowbotham, Ms. Lehman)

Results will be released after regular polls have closed to avoid potentially influencing the election, as per Elections BC regulations.

MADD Canada Presentation - Oct 17th for ALL Grade 11 & 12 students - POSTPONED - we will update students and families about a new date for this presentation when we have it confirmed.

On Thursday, Oct 17, Rockridge will host MADD Canada as their trained facilitators will present their new film: *One Last Dance.* The film's fictional story illustrates the tragic consequences of driving while impaired by alcohol and/or drugs. Throughout the film, students are shown times when the tragedy could have been prevented by making different choices. This *School Program* is proven-effective at encouraging responsible decision-making among youth – both immediately after the presentation and longer term. In the 2022-2023 evaluation survey among participating students, 92% said the program makes them want to make the right decision when it comes to impaired driving and 82% said that they

were likely to make a plan for getting home safely when going out with friends. The majority of students felt that consuming cannabis would cause one to drive "a lot worse" with 86% saying this after the presentation and 91% 3-months post presentation. Furthermore, three months after the presentation, half of respondents were more likely to think that cannabis use has a negative effect on the ability to drive.

Please complete this requirement this week and avoid an email from the principal next week.

This online verification and consent form requires a parent login and must be submitted for each student at the start of each school year. We ask that it is submitted ONLY ONCE PER STUDENT in September, as the upload gets very onerous with multiple submissions. For later changes, please inform the office.

- If you previously created an account to complete the 22/23 form, the account is the same.
- If you have forgotten your password, you can follow the instructions to reset it.
- Once logged in, you will have the option to either update a P+P form created last year or start a new one.
- Without a completed consent form, students will not be permitted to attend field trips, join school teams or have their photos included in the yearbook. Permissions expire on August 31 each year.

ATTENTION DOG WALKERS

The Rockridge sports field is a Classroom space, used by classes and teams, many of which have begun regular practices and games this fall. There has been a large amount of Dog Poop that is not only a distraction and slipping hazard, but also a health issue. We remind our community members that West Vancouver Bylaw prohibits dogs on the field and thank you for your cooperation in respecting this outdoor classroom space. *We would appreciate it if you would pass this on to other community members who should have this information.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS?

If there are any changes to address, legal custody, or citizenship status, please upload documentation to support the changes using this link. The changes will not be reflected until the documentation is submitted.

ATTENDANCE - Notifying the Office and Extended Absences

If you know your student will not be in attendance for all, or part of a school day, we ask that you please let our office know in advance - rockridge@wvschools.ca Please include your child's first and last name and reason for absence in your email.

Daily attendance is critical to ensure student success here at Rockridge. **We do not recommend** absences during the school term but realize they may be unavoidable. Please keep in mind that certain classroom activities and assessments may not be able to be made up if missed.

Please notify the school a minimum of one week in advance using this **form** for an extended absence. Teachers are not required to provide extra classes, make-up tests or specific work to be completed.

School Drop Off/Pick Up Safety

As you are probably aware, there can be heavy traffic around our school site at opening and dismissal times. It is difficult for vehicles to enter and exit our school parking areas as well as the Caulfeild Mall. The passage of emergency vehicles would be impeded which is of considerable concern. Please consider carpooling, dropping off and picking up your children at a predetermined location away from the school property, and encouraging active transportation (biking, walking). Another helpful action, if possible, for those that have to drive is dropping off your child early. An 8:00 AM arrival is always a great plan and chance to hang in the cafeteria, get some work done at a hallway workstation, or connect with a teacher.

Please note that designated visitor parking spaces at the front of the school are a 'no parking' zone in the morning and after school. The driveway in front of the school entrance is a NO STOPPING zone. All numbered parking spaces are designated for individual staff members. Please do not park in these spaces at any time during school hours.
