# A MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

To begin this week's E-Bulletin I'd like to make a special shout out to our hardworking Class of 2025 who completed their Graduation Literacy Assessments (GLAs) this week. They are yet another step closer to graduation as we wrap up this final day of October.

Halloween was celebrated here at The Rock today with lots of costumes and treats. The annual costume contest in Players Hall was packed with staff and students once again and certainly reflects the positive school spirit that makes our school a special and fun place to be. This time of year, and tonight especially, always sparks the topic of safety. It is important to note the sale and use of fireworks are banned in West Vancouver and the City of North Vancouver. The District of North Vancouver permits private pyrotechnic displays on a limited basis but permits are required to be purchased by those 19 years of age and older.

A second safety topic for conversation this weekend is for those families that have a Raven who commutes to school by bike, especially Ebike. If you notice your student is not wearing a helmet, please take time to discuss safety regulations in BC with your child. Our staff have had conversations with any students we have seen not wearing a helmet out of an abundance of care and concern. Please complete this requirement this week and avoid an email from the principal next week. This online verification and consent form requires a parent login and must be submitted for each student at the start of each school year. We ask that it is submitted ONLY ONCE PER STUDENT in September, as the upload gets very onerous with multiple submissions. For later changes, please inform the office.

- If you previously created an account to complete the 22/23 form, the account is the same.
- If you have forgotten your password, you can follow the instructions to reset it.
- Once logged in, you will have the option to either update a P+P form created last year or start a new one.
- Without a completed consent form, students will not be permitted to attend field trips, join school teams or have their photos included in the yearbook. Permissions expire on August 31 each year.

#### **ATTENTION DOG WALKERS**

The Rockridge sports field is a Classroom space, used by classes and teams, many of which have begun regular practices and games this fall. There has been a large amount of Dog Poop that is not only a distraction and slipping hazard, but also a health issue. We remind our community members that West Vancouver Bylaw prohibits dogs on the field and thank you for your cooperation in respecting this outdoor classroom space. \*We would appreciate it if you would pass this on to other community members who should have this information.

#### **CHANGE OF ADDRESS?**

If there are any changes to address, legal custody, or citizenship status, please upload documentation to support the changes using this link. The changes will not be reflected until the documentation is submitted.

#### **ATTENDANCE - Notifying the Office and Extended Absences**

If you know your student will not be in attendance for all, or part of a school day, we ask that you please let our office know in advance - rockridge@wvschools.ca Please include your child's first and last name and reason for absence in your email.

Daily attendance is critical to ensure student success here at Rockridge. **We do not recommend** absences during the school term but realize they may be unavoidable. Please keep in mind that certain classroom activities and assessments may not be able to be made up if missed.

Please notify the school a minimum of one week in advance using this **form** for an extended absence. Teachers are not required to provide extra classes, make-up tests or specific work to be completed.

#### School Drop Off/Pick Up Safety

As you are probably aware, there can be heavy traffic around our school site at opening and dismissal times. It is difficult for vehicles to enter and exit our school parking areas as well as the Caulfeild Mall. The passage of emergency vehicles would be impeded which is of considerable concern. Please consider carpooling, dropping off and picking up your children at a predetermined location away from the school property, and encouraging active transportation (biking, walking). Another helpful action, if possible, for those that have to drive is dropping off your child early. An 8:00 AM arrival is always a great plan and chance to hang in the cafeteria, get some work done at a hallway workstation, or connect with a teacher.

Please note that designated visitor parking spaces at the front of the school are a 'no parking' zone in the morning and after school. The driveway in front of the school entrance is a NO STOPPING zone. All numbered parking spaces are designated for individual staff members. Please do not park in these spaces at any time during school hours.
