Your Rockridge MYP Coordinators are back again with another policy for you to have a look at!

OUR LANGUAGE POLICY:

The next policy we'd like to share with you is our Language Policy. This policy talks about how we support our learners in learning languages here at Rockridge! This includes our various English, English-Language-Learner, French and Spanish courses. The IB celebrates language learning and emphasizes the importance of being open to continually learning and developing our understanding of not only a student's best language, but other languages as well. The emphasis is to increase their understanding of other cultures (including their own), and explore important world ideas/issues through different perspectives.

We are very lucky to have a committed, dynamic languages team, including the support of our wonderful Library Learning Commons. Check out what they have to offer for our MYP grades!

LEARNING UPDATE 1 INFO:

The first update will be released TOMORROW!

All MYP courses (Grades 8 - 10) will have Levels 1 - 8 associated with their subject specific criterion categories.

Here are two tips to help you navigate through your MYP student's first learning update:

1) What the Levels Mean

Your first reminder is the Levels are aligned with the new BC Proficiency Scale. So if you see a Level of 4 for a specific criterion, it does NOT mean that your student received a 4 out of 8. It means the following:

A passing level in a course is considered a 2.

If a 1 or an IE (insufficient evidence) is present, students will be given a supportive action plan to help get them back on track in the remainder of the course.

2) Not All Criterion Categories May Be Assessed in a Course At This Time

Because we are running in a linear system, the pacing is more spread out, so courses may not have had enough time to assess all four criterions for their subject area. The minimum number of criterions to be assessed in a subject by Learning Update 1 is TWO.

This means, some courses will have two criterion categories assessed, others will have three, and others might have four! So, if you see a blank, don't panic!

(ALL subject areas will have ALL FOUR criterions assessed by Learning Update 2.)

Online Policies & Procedures Form 2024-2025 - Now at 82% of online consent forms completed!

This online verification and consent form requires a parent login and must be submitted for each student at the start of each school year. We ask that it is submitted ONLY ONCE PER STUDENT in September, as the upload gets very onerous with multiple submissions. For later changes, please inform the office.

- If you previously created an account to complete the 22/23 form, the account is the same.
- If you have forgotten your password, you can follow the instructions to reset it.
- Once logged in, you will have the option to either update a P+P form created last year or start a new one.
- Without a completed consent form, students will not be permitted to attend field trips, join school teams or have their photos included in the yearbook. Permissions expire on August 31 each year.

School Drop Off/Pick Up Safety

As you are probably aware, there can be heavy traffic around our school site at opening and dismissal times. It is difficult for vehicles to enter and exit our school parking areas as well as the Caulfeild Mall. The passage of emergency vehicles would be impeded which is of considerable concern. Please consider carpooling, dropping off and picking up your children at a predetermined location away from the school property, and encouraging active transportation (biking, walking). Another helpful action, if possible, for those that have to drive is dropping off your child early. An 8:00 AM arrival is always a great plan and chance to hang in the cafeteria, get some work done at a hallway workstation, or connect with a teacher.

Please note that designated visitor parking spaces at the front of the school are a 'no parking' zone in the morning and after school. The driveway in front of the school entrance is a NO STOPPING zone. All numbered parking spaces are designated for individual staff members. Please do not park in these spaces at any time during school hours.

ATTENTION DOG WALKERS

The Rockridge sports field is a classroom space, used by classes and teams, many of which have begun regular practices and games this fall. There has been a large amount of Dog Poop that is not only a distraction and slipping hazard, but also a health issue. We remind our community members that West Vancouver Bylaw prohibits dogs on the field and thank you for your cooperation in respecting this outdoor classroom space. *We would appreciate it if you would pass this on to other community members who should have this information.
