A MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Looking at the calendar we have a lot of opportunities ahead for students, parents, and staff to talk about learning here at Rockridge in the days ahead. Parent Teacher Interviews are perhaps top of mind for many of you and if not . . . there is still time to make requests in our system - just see the details below. Monday's Professional Development Day gathers all staff across the district at WVSS for a variety of learning sessions. There are two notable upcoming presentations of learning we would like you to attend - the Grade 10 Personal Project Exhibition and Theatre Company Performance. In the Raven Life this week there is a unique photo from our AP Psychology class showcasing one of the unique learning opportunities in that course. Earlier this week I was speaking with some ROPAC members, and we were reflecting on how important it is for me to share stories of student success from all realms of experiences here at The Rock. With this in mind, we have a new feature in our E-Bulletin called **Did You Know We Rock?** (I haven't settled on this title, but will try it out for this week).

DID YOU KNOW WE ROCK?

In response to the question above, I say "The results speak for themselves". A remarkable 85% of our graduates transition to postsecondary education directly after graduation, with over half attending top universities outside of BC and Canada including McGill, U of T, Oxford, and UCLA. Two years after graduation, this number reaches 90% and higher. Alternatively, the average across BC of graduates who attend post secondary directly after graduation is approximately 50%. This level of success is no coincidence—our counsellors and Careers Department provide unmatched guidance, ensuring students have the tools to navigate competitive admissions processes and secure spots in elite programs, from Ivy League schools to direct-entry medicine, law, and beyond. This kind of leadership and guidance at Rockridge is not common in a public school setting, but it is part of the culture of our school and is one of the structures that leads to our student's success.

ACTION ITEMS FOR ROCKRIDGE PARENTS/GUARDIANS

Online Policies & Procedures Form 2024-2025 - Now at 84% of online consent forms completed!

This online verification and consent form requires a parent login and must be submitted for each student at the start of each school year. We ask that it is submitted ONLY ONCE PER STUDENT in September, as the upload gets very onerous with multiple submissions. For later changes, please inform the office.

- If you previously created an account to complete the 22/23 form, the account is the same.
- If you have forgotten your password, you can follow the instructions to reset it.
- Once logged in, you will have the option to either update a P+P form created last year or start a new one.
- Without a completed consent form, students will not be permitted to attend field trips, join school teams or have their photos included in the yearbook. Permissions expire on August 31 each year.

School Drop Off/Pick Up Safety

As you are probably aware, there can be heavy traffic around our school site at opening and dismissal times. It is difficult for vehicles to enter and exit our school parking areas as well as the Caulfeild Mall. The passage of emergency vehicles would be impeded which is of considerable concern. Please consider carpooling, dropping off and picking up your children at a predetermined location away from the school property, and encouraging active transportation (biking, walking). Another helpful action, if possible, for those that have to drive is dropping off your child early. An 8:00 AM arrival is always a great plan and chance to hang in the cafeteria, get some work done at a hallway workstation, or connect with a teacher.

Please note that designated visitor parking spaces at the front of the school are a 'no parking' zone in the morning and after school. The driveway in front of the school entrance is a NO STOPPING zone. All numbered parking spaces are designated for individual staff members. Please do not park in these spaces at any time during school hours.

ATTENTION DOG WALKERS

The Rockridge sports field is a Classroom space, used by classes and teams, many of which have begun regular practices and games this fall. There has been a large amount of Dog Poop that is not only a distraction and slipping hazard, but also a health issue. We remind our community members that West Vancouver Bylaw prohibits dogs on the field and thank you for your cooperation in respecting this outdoor classroom space. *We would appreciate it if you would pass this on to other community members who should have this information.
