#### FROM YOUR MYP COORDINATORS:

THIS is the week, parents! You will be able to access the second "Learning Update" (the new name for report cards) on MyEd TOMORROW on <u>Friday, March 7th, 2025</u> for the Rockridge student(s) in your household.

Here are a few reminders as you navigate the latest learning update:

#### 1) What the Levels Mean in Grades 8 - 10

The MYP Levels are aligned with the BC Proficiency Scale. So if you see a Level of 4 for a specific criterion, it does NOT mean that your student received a 4 out of 8. It means the following:

Emerging	Developing	Proficient	Extending
Levels 1 - 2	Levels 3 - 4	Levels 5 - 6	Levels 7 - 8
Demonstrates an initial understanding of the expected learning.	Demonstrates a partial understanding of the expected learning.	Demonstrates a complete understanding of the expected learning.	Demonstrates a sophisticated understanding of the expected learning.

A passing level in a course is considered a 2.

If a 1 or an IE (insufficient evidence) is present, students will be given a supportive action plan to help get them back on track in the remainder of the course. You will receive this from the teacher in your email.

# 2) PLEASE read Learning Update 2

Teachers at Rockridge care about students and their learning. They take the time to provide quality feedback about how a student is doing. Please look at your student's criterion levels and take the time to read each teacher's comments. Their comments will follow the intro, "Learning"

Update 2 Comment:"

Should you have any clarifying questions or if you're not clear on how to further support your Rockridge student in their learning, please follow up with the associated subject teacher.

#### 3) Learning Takes Time

Perhaps your student isn't content with the levels they are receiving at this time. Remind them (and yourself!) that growing and learning takes time. They will not remain at these levels if they're willing to thoughtfully reflect on what has been and make some concrete plans to lean into the spaces that need attention.

Students might need your help strategizing and prioritizing. Listen to them. Reflect with them on their efforts to take responsibility with their learning. Take a breath. Discuss together how it best makes sense to move forward.

We hope these reminders are helpful to you as you navigate the second learning update of the year. Happy reading everyone!

# Online Policies & Procedures Form 2024-2025 - NOW 89% of online consent forms completed!

This online verification and consent form requires a parent login and must be submitted for each student at the start of each school year. We ask that it is submitted ONLY ONCE PER STUDENT in September, as the upload gets very onerous with multiple submissions. For later changes, please inform the office.

- If you previously created an account to complete the 22/23 form, the account is the same.
- If you have forgotten your password, you can follow the instructions to reset it.
- Once logged in, you will have the option to either update a P+P form created last year or start a new one.
- Without a completed consent form, students will not be permitted to attend field trips, join school teams or have their photos included in the yearbook. Permissions expire on August 31 each year.

# **ATTENDANCE - Notifying the Office and Extended Absences**

Daily attendance is critical to ensure student success here at Rockridge. **We do not recommend** absences during the school term but realize they may be unavoidable. Please keep in mind that certain classroom activities and assessments may not be able to be made up if missed.

Please notify the school a minimum of one week in advance using this **form** for an extended absence. Teachers are not required to provide extra classes, make-up tests or specific work to be completed.

#### School Drop Off/Pick Up Safety

As you are probably aware, there can be heavy traffic around our school site at opening and dismissal times. It is difficult for vehicles to enter and exit our school parking areas as well as the Caulfeild Mall. The passage of emergency vehicles would be impeded which is of considerable concern. Please consider carpooling, dropping off and picking up your children at a predetermined location away from the school

property, and encouraging active transportation (biking, walking). Another helpful action, if possible, for those that have to drive is dropping off your child early. An 8:00 AM arrival is always a great plan and chance to hang in the cafeteria, get some work done at a hallway workstation, or connect with a teacher.

Please note that designated visitor parking spaces at the front of the school are a 'no parking' zone in the morning and after school. The driveway in front of the school entrance is a NO STOPPING zone. All numbered parking spaces are designated for individual staff members. Please do not park in these spaces at any time during school hours.

#### **ATTENTION DOG WALKERS**

The Rockridge sports field is a Classroom space, used by classes and teams, many of which have begun regular practices and games this fall. There has been a large amount of Dog Poop that is not only a distraction and slipping hazard, but also a health issue. We remind our community members that West Vancouver Bylaw prohibits dogs on the field and thank you for your cooperation in respecting this outdoor classroom space. \*We would appreciate it if you would pass this on to other community members who should have this information.
