



Social Studies students had the opportunity to listen to and meet the former director of ADRA, Carl Wilkens. He was the only American who chose to stay during the Rwandan Genocide of 1994, and saved around 400 orphans. To have someone live through such horror and talk authentically about love, and wrestling with how people make decisions is something that will remain with them for a long time. Many of our students asked him deep questions about empathy, the psychology of genocide vs love, and how his story changed his perspective on the world.


