The main thing for parents/guardians to do before arriving is having a copy, or photo of your child's schedule so you can follow the block order to see the correct teachers at the right time. Our teachers are an incredible team and I am extremely proud of the work that they do here at The Rock to engage and support student learning and excellence. I look forward to you meeting our staff in person to make a personal connection for the year ahead.

You will notice below that we are only at 46% completion rate for our student forms. Please take a moment to review the following information if you are part of our missing 54%.

PARENT/GUARDIANS TO DO <u>TODAY</u>: Thank you for the strong start of respondents who have completed the two forms required for each of our students. As shared last week, to ensure a safe and successful start to the school year, we ask you to complete two important forms for each student in your household. One is reviewing, making any updates to, and signing the single paper form called the **Student Verification Form**, which students were asked to bring home on the first day of school. The second form is the **Online Policies & Procedures Form**; <a href="https://eforms.sd45.bc.ca/Form/PandP">https://eforms.sd45.bc.ca/Form/PandP</a>
Both forms must be submitted in the first days of the year. Without them, your child's participation in activities both in and outside of the classroom will be limited. Thus far we have 46% of students' P&P consent successfully submitted online.

If you have not yet completed these please see the attached letter called 2025-2026 Required Annual Parent/Guardian Forms Communication for full details. In addition, if your student(s) is to be absent from school or requires an early dismissal for an appointment, the procedure is to email <a href="mailto:rockridge@wvschools.ca">rockridge@wvschools.ca</a> with the full student name, grade, and reason for absence/dismissal. This will ensure that the absence is noted as excused and you will not receive an email/voicemail alert regarding the absence.

# A GREAT WAY TO SUPPORT YOUR STUDENT: Sharing this again this week as it is such a helpful activity to engage in regularly with your Rockridge Raven.

Parents do not have access to Google Classrooms (GC), however, we feel it is important to review your child's GC regularly with them so that they can inform you about their classes, learning and upcoming or incomplete assignments. This looks like sitting down with your child at their laptop and having them open and scroll through their GC. A helpful thing for parents and guardians to see this week are the Grade Level (or Grad Class Google Classroom) for Homeroom Presentations from Opening Week. # STUDENT PARKING AT ROCKRIDGE

Parking is available for Senior Students (Priority is given to Grade 12) in the Upper Lot east of the Gym. Students must complete a parking <u>Registration form</u>, noting vehicle details, insurance expiry, obtain parent signature and submit to the office. The \$25 decal fee must be paid through <u>School Cash Online</u>. Once the form is returned and payment completed, we can issue a decal.

Note: At no time are students permitted to park in Visitor or Staff designated spots

# **ATTENDANCE - Notifying the Office and Extended Absences**

If you know your student will not be in attendance for all, or part of a school day, we ask that you please let our office know in advance - rockridge@wvschools.ca If your student will be arriving late, leaving early, or missing part of the day, please include approximate times of arrival and dismissal in your email. Please include your child's first and last name and reason for absence in your email.

Daily attendance is critical to ensure student success here at Rockridge. We do not recommend absences during the school term but realize they may be unavoidable. Please keep in mind that certain classroom activities and assessments may not be able to be made up if missed.

Please notify the school a minimum of one week in advance using this **form** for an extended absence. Teachers are not required to provide extra classes, make-up tests or specific work to be completed.

# **SMS for Parents/Guardians:**

Parents and guardians have an option to receive text messages for school emergencies or other important alerts: Part of the WV Schools communication system allows families to opt into receiving important information additionally by text. For parents/guardians who would like to be notified of a school emergency such as power outages, severe weather or safety alerts via SMS please text a "Y" or "Yes" to 978338 to ensure you are on the list.

# School Drop Off/Pick Up Safety

As you are probably aware, there can be heavy traffic around our school site at opening and dismissal times. It is difficult for vehicles to enter and exit our school parking areas as well as the Caulfeild Mall. The passage of emergency vehicles would be impeded which is of considerable concern. Please consider carpooling, dropping off and picking up your children at a predetermined location away from the school property, and encouraging active transportation (biking, walking). Another helpful action, if possible, for those that have to drive is dropping off your child early. An 8:00 AM arrival is always a great plan and chance to hang in the cafeteria, get some work done at a hallway workstation, or connect with a teacher.

Please note that designated visitor parking spaces at the front of the school are a 'no parking' zone in the morning and after school. The driveway in front of the school entrance is a NO STOPPING zone. All numbered parking spaces are designated for individual staff members. Please do not park in these spaces at any time during school hours.
