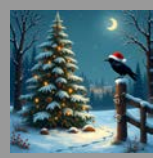


Ms. Donald's Grade 8s had a great time with their ceramic Winter Trees, learning slab-building and glazing skills in the process.

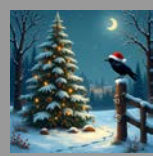
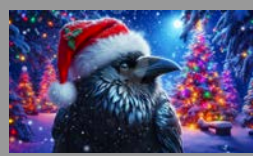
Rockridge students made up 750 bags for food for Backpack Buddies.



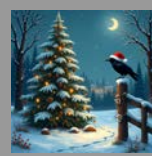
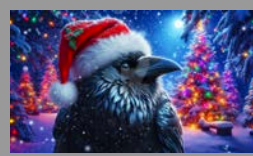
