NEW BUSINESS

- PYP enhancement reviewed by Janet Hicks
- Focus on quality improvement of learning program: constantly refining and understanding how children learn best
- This year, focus is on inquiry-based learning and for children to spend more time on play (pre K and kindergarten levels)
- 3 sections highlighted in presentation which is attached (learning, teaching, learning community)
- Focus on reflection for learning
- Curriculum will stay the same and remains student-centered
- Number of units of inquiry for early learners 4 instead of 6 units of inquiry to allow for more uninterrupted play to enhance socialization
- PYP planners are used to discover student agency -voice/choice/ownership
- Importance of home language as part of learning
- Students have ability to adapt their learning to the community of West Bay and its context
- Program evaluation in 2020
