Hot Lunch this session has been successful and brought in more revenue than anticipated. This term's total (\$96,325) was higher than last term's (\$69833) We will continue to pay out expenses against Hot Lunch (cost of food) for the remainder of the school year.

Poinsettia sales brought in a profit of \$391

We have started generating expenses for this upcoming gala and will have more to update closer to the gala.

Our budgeted expenses are on track for the year, have spent 29% of our allocated amount.
