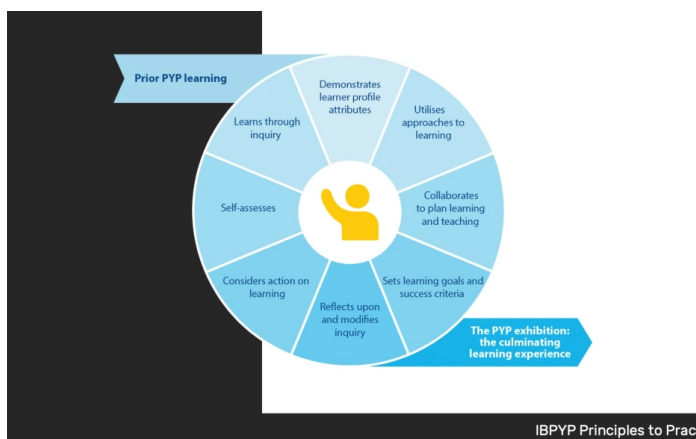




Exhibition at West Bay

Students will explore, document, and share their understanding of an issue or opportunity of personal significance. This will be done with the guidance of their classroom teacher, their mentor and the IB Coordinator.

The Process

Central Idea



Learners are able to structure their inquiry into a global issue or opportunity and are able to demonstrate an understanding of the central idea.

Conceptual Understanding



Learners are able to develop lines of inquiry and guiding questions that support their central idea and will enable them to pursue their inquiry.

Action



Based on a plan that clearly addresses a need as defined by the inquiry. Learners are able to articulate the action they will undertake in order to impact social justice, lifestyle choices, participation, advocacy, or social entrepreneurship

Approaches to Learning



Learners can identify and reflect on chosen ATLs and can provide evidence of development for the work shared within the Exhibition (reflections, meetings with Mentor, research, action, celebration of learning).

Learner Profile



Learners use the language of the learner profile within their written work. Learners plan for and exemplify the attributes of a learner profile as identified by self, peers, teacher, mentor, throughout the Exhibition process.
