## PAC Update:

Procuring items is also difficult in the covid hit economy. We are leaning towards in-house items such as kids volunteering to cut grass. Michelle is looking at possibly someone donating their time or items to beautify the classrooms such as carpets, lamps, bookshelves and tables or painting.

**Bingo** – probably at the end of Jan / early Feb. Need a lead for this activity. We now have the equipment and no longer have to rent. Has always been a great community building event. **Ping Pong tournament** – Irwin Park had such an event and it was a great community building event.
