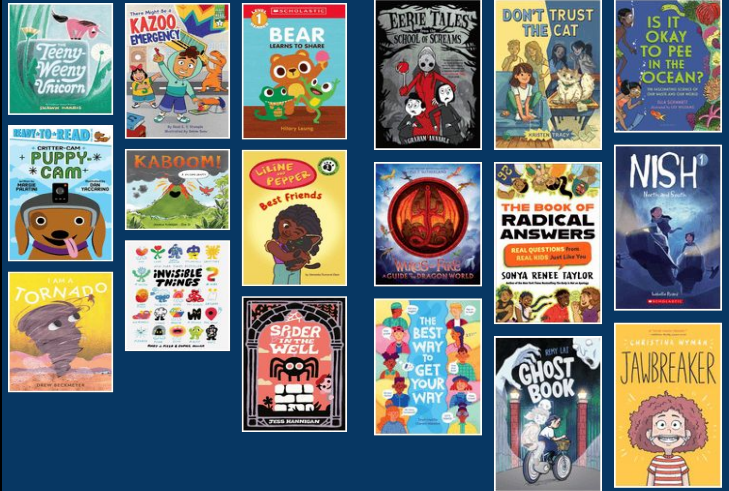
We found caddisfly, and mayfly insects which were clues telling us that there was a lot of oxygen in the water and no pollution!

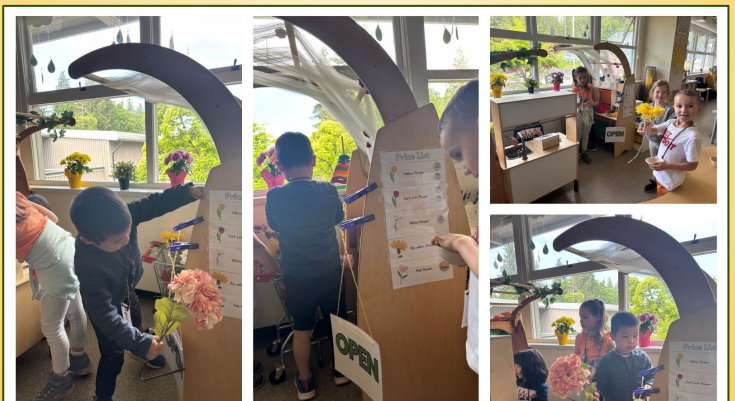


BUILDING READING FLUENCY IN GRADE 1

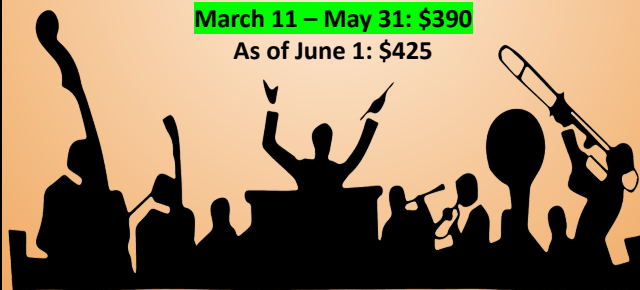
2024-25 ELEMENTARY BAND PROGRAM
