RETURN TO SCHOOL ON 2025-2026

Our funding from the Ministry of Education and Child Care requires that we confirm our enrollment and therefore we must have students in attendance by this time. 25-26 PARENT INPUT FOR CLASS PLACEMENT **OPEN UNTIL FRIDAY 16 MAY**

Dear Parents/Guardians, Over the coming months, West Bay teachers will configure students into classes for the 2025-2026 school year. You may complete this form to share information you feel should be considered when placing your child for the next school year. This form is optional.

The class placement process is very complex as teachers consider the individual needs of students as well as group dynamics. When placing students, school personnel consider teachers' observations of individual needs and social dynamics, input from support staff, class size and composition (learning and behavior needs, gender), and learning styles.

Parent feedback is valued and will be considered, but it is important for families to know that there are many other factors that affect the placement of students and teachers' observations drive placement decisions.

If you hope that your child is placed with close peers, please note that we aim to place children with peers who they learn well with (feel connected to; support each other's learning; don't distract each other; and make good decisions together).

If you have input, please ensure it is shared before this form closes on Friday, May 16, so that it can be taken into consideration.


BODY SYSTEM POSTER PROJECT

Over the last few weeks, gr 5 students have worked hard on an interactive mixed-media poster to showcase their understanding of how the lungs, heart, and stomach work—and how they connect with each other to keep us healthy.

This multi-step project included:

- Building the Body Systems using 3D and mixed media materials to accurately represent each system's appearance and location in the body.
- Highlighting Healthy Habits with at least five lifestyle choices per system, including both positive and negative habits.
- Creating Cue Cards that explain each system's main job, how it works with the others, fun facts, and ways to care for it.
- Making Connections between systems using color codes, lines, or symbols to show how one habit can affect multiple parts of the body.
- Reflecting on Learning with thoughtful responses about their design choices, new understandings, and one healthy habit they want to try.

We're incredibly proud of the creativity, collaboration, and critical thinking students demonstrated during this project.

GENTLY DOWN THE SEYMOURThe importance of Salmon Conservation

Grade 3 students recently had a great day of discovery in 3 stations during a Hatchery Tour to learn about the stages Salmon go through - they visited the different holding tanks for fish, explored the River Specimen Collection looking at invertebrates under microscopes, and completed a Stream Survey to measure the depth and width of the River, the size of salmon reds and observe to see if it was a healthy environment for fish to return to.
