Kindergarten and In-Catchment Gr 1-7 Registration For 2024-25 School Year If you, or anyone you know, has a child born in 2019, please note that registration for Kindergarten 2024/25 opens at 8:00am, Monday October 16th. Registration also opens at this time for any in-catchment families with children going into Grades 1-7. The online registration application can be found HERE. Please note out of catchment

Grade 1-7 registrations and out of district applications for secondary schools are not accepted until January

For Westcot Grade 7 students and families, if your first choice for Grade 8 is West Vancouver Secondary **School** or Sentinel **Secondary School** (Westcot is a dual feeder school) you are not required to complete an online application regardless of where they live. West Vancouver Secondary School and Sentinel Secondary counsellors will be visiting in late winter/early spring and distributing transfer forms at that time. HOWEVER, if your first choice for secondary school is **Rockridge Secondary**, you must complete an online application according to the student registration timelines. Please note: No out of catchment or out of district
