Daily Health Check It is important that parents **continue** to do a thorough **DAILY HEALTH CHECK**. At school we have always followed the same procedures regarding student illnesses - when children are sick and not well enough to be at school and participate **fully in all aspects of the day**, for any reason, parents will be contacted and asked to pick up their child. The purpose of this has always been to ensure the child receives the care they need and that the illness is not spread at the school.

Student Absent from School? Please Call the Callback Line 604-981-1276. (Not the Office) before 8:00 am As part of the Westcot safety program all students are accounted for each day as either absent or present. A Call Back program is in place to check on students who are absent if no contact with the school has been made. We will continue to carefully monitor all absences and ask that you use this central communication rather than or as well as emailing individual classroom teachers. Parents can help with the overall efficiency of this process by informing the school if your child is going to be absent. Simply call the callback line at **604-981-1276**.

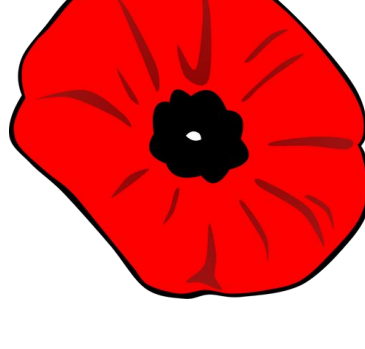
Westcot's Framework for Enhancing Student Learning 2021-24 The BC Ministry of Education requires each school in our province to have a multi-year school plan (FESL) that outlines a goal focused upon improving student learning. The framework is to be evidence-informed and outline a clear action plan to improve student learning. At Westcot we are engaged in a cycle of learning that is proving to be highly successful for our students. Westcot staff is currently focusing on how staff and families can improve student learning and student achievement in all aspects of literacy. We have begun by focusing on and sharing all the resources and strategies currently in place in our District, in each of our classrooms, our ELL programs and our Learning Support programs. We have shared our progress at the District Board Meeting in September and have welcomed staff from a number of West Vancouver Schools wanting to learn more. Staff and students are excited to share this work within our Learning Community. If you have a child in grades K - 3 ask them about UFLI, in grades 4 - 7 ask them about their word journals. Top Five Timely Asks and Reminders from the staff at Westcot— In addition to daily health checks and sending healthy, well rested students to schools...



- Punctuality Please. Arrive on time.** Arriving late continues to be concerning, disruptive to classrooms and results in missed learning opportunities. **Pick up on time** and be sure to directly supervise your children if they continue to play on the playground or field.
- Be Prepared.** Take time each morning to ensure your child has lunch, snack, utensils, water bottle and all of the materials they will need for learning. In grades 4 - 7 this includes a **charged** device.
- Appointment Scheduling.** Please continue to make appointments for your child **outside of school time** whenever possible.
- Parking Etiquette. Please do not block the driveway** of our neighbours or our school at drop off and pick up. Be respectful and quick if you are using the parking lot at St. David's.
- Weather reminder.** Please ensure your child is dressed for the weather. In primary classes please ensure your child has a change of clothes and inside shoes that remain in the classroom.

Bringing Your Own Cutlery Please make sure your child is bringing their own cutlery. We also want to remind you that the "pack-it-in/pack-it-out" policy is in effect which means that students are expected to pack out their lunch waste, such as leftover food and lunch containers. Students must bring their own food and drink at the start of the school day; this includes snacks, lunch, and water bottles. There will be no sharing of food or drink and there will be no mid-day drop offs and deliveries of food items (or any other items). **We are a Nut Aware school. Please do not send nut based foods in students snacks or lunches.**

Kindergarten and In-Catchment Gr 1-7 Registration For 2024-25 School Year If you, or anyone you know, has a child born in 2019, please note that registration for Kindergarten/25 opens at 8:00am, Monday October 16th. Registration also opens at this time for any in-catchment families with children going into Grades 1-7. The online registration application can be found [HERE](#). Please note out of catchment Grade 1-7 registrations and out of district applications for secondary schools are not accepted until January 15, 2024.

For Westcot Grade 7 students and families, if your first choice for Grade 8 is **West Vancouver Secondary School** or **Sentinel Secondary School** (Westcot is a dual feeder school) you are not required to complete an online application regardless of where they live. West Vancouver Secondary School and Sentinel Secondary School counsellors will be visiting in late winter/early spring and distributing transfer forms at that time. **HOWEVER**, if your first choice for secondary school is **Rockridge Secondary**, you must complete an online application according to the [student registration timelines](#). **Please note: No out of catchment or out of district applications for secondary are accepted until January 15, 2024.**
