Daily Health Check It is important that parents **continue** to do a thorough **DAILY HEALTH CHECK**. At school we have always followed the same procedures regarding student illnesses - when children are sick and not well enough to be at school and participate **fully in all aspects of the day**, for any reason, parents will be contacted and asked to pick up their child. The purpose of this has always been to ensure the child receives the care they need and that the illness is not spread at the school.

(Not the Office) before 8:00 am As part of the Westcot safety program all students are accounted for each day as either absent or present. A Call Back program is in place to check on students who are absent if no contact with the school has been made. We will continue to carefully monitor all absences and ask that you use this central communication rather than or as well as emailing individual classroom teachers. Parents can help with the overall efficiency of this process by informing the school if your child is going to be absent. Simply call the callback line at **604-981-1276.**

Troubleshooting Tips:

- 1. The portal will not work with a cell phone or tablet. You will need to use a PC or laptop.
- 2. The portal works best if you are using Google Chrome.
- 3. Don't copy and paste your username and password. You will need to type it in.
- 4. Enable pop ups.
- 5. <u>Video</u> instructions (4 min)
- 6. Families who have an existing Family Portal -When you log in it will say "Your password has expired. Please create a new password". Hit OK and follow the instructions on how to create a new password.
- Click "I forgot my password" if you cannot remember your password a reset link will be sent to your email as with other secure sites.

MyEd: Parent Student Login - BC Services card Login Option

There is now a new option for MyEd Logins. This change will give parents and students the option to login to their MyEd accounts using their BC Services Card. Bringing Your Own Cutlery Please make sure your child is bringing their own cutlery. We also want to remind you that the "pack-it-in/pack-it-out" policy is in effect which means that students are expected to pack out their lunch waste, such as leftover food and lunch containers. Students must bring their own food and drink at the start of the school day; this includes snacks, lunch, and water bottles. There will be no sharing of food or drink and there will be no mid-day drop offs and deliveries of food items (or any other items). We are a Nut Aware school. Please do not send nut based foods in students snacks or lunches.

Kindergarten and In-Catchment Gr 1-7 Registration For 2024-25 School Year If you, or anyone you know, has a child born in 2019, please note that registration for Kindergarten 2024/25 opens at 8:00am, Monday October 16th. Registration also opens at this time for any in-catchment families with children going into Grades 1-7. The online registration application can be found <u>HERE</u>. Please note out of catchment Grade 1-7 registrations and out of district applications for secondary schools are not accepted until January 15, 2024.

For Westcot Grade 7 students and families, if your first choice for Grade 8 is **West Vancouver Secondary School** or Sentinel **Secondary School** (Westcot is a dual feeder school) you are not required to complete an online application regardless of where they live. West Vancouver Secondary School and Sentinel Secondary counsellors will be visiting in late winter/early spring and distributing transfer forms at that time. HOWEVER, if your first choice for secondary school is **Rockridge Secondary**, you must complete an online application

according to the <u>student registration timelines</u>. *Please note:* No out of catchment or out of district applications for secondary are accepted until January 15, 2024.
