Daily Health Check It is important that parents **continue** to do a thorough **DAILY HEALTH CHECK**. At school we have always followed the same procedures regarding student illnesses - when children are sick and not well enough to be at school and participate **fully in all aspects of the day**, for any reason, parents will be contacted and asked to pick up their child. The purpose of this has always been to ensure the child receives the care they need and that the illness is not spread at the school.

Student Absent from School? Please Call the Callback Line 604-981-1276. (Not the Office Please) before 8:00 am As part of the Westcot safety program all students are accounted for each day as either absent or present. A Call Back program is in place to check on students who are absent if no contact with the school has been made. We will continue to carefully monitor all absences and ask that you use this central communication rather than or as well as emailing individual classroom teachers. Parents can help with the overall efficiency of this process by informing the school if your child is going to be absent. Simply call the callback line at **604-981-1276.**

Opening Day and Week for Grade 1 – 7 students....

The schedule on September 3:

Similar to last year, our students will make their way to the gravel field **independently** where they will be greeted by our Westcot staff. Students will line up and enter with their grade group for a welcome and orientation to the new school year.

• 9:00 - 10:00 am Grade 1 -7

Students will be walked out to meet their families at the end of the day.

September 4th and onwards, Grades 1-7 scheduling will look as follows:

- 8:40 am 2:40 pm Grades 1 4
- 8:50 am 2:50 pm Grades 5 7

Kindergarten students will follow the Gradual Entry plan shared in July.

Students will continue to line up **at the start time** on the **gravel field.** They will be walked out at the end of the day. Please establish a meeting location offsite for your children to connect with you. Children **directly supervised by an adult** are welcome to play on the playground at the end of the day.

Students not in attendance by September 5: Will not have a guaranteed spot at Westcot. Students must be present in class by September 5th at the latest to be registered.



District On-line Release Forms All Parents in the district are asked **annually** to complete a West Van District Policy and Procedures online form for **each** of their children within the district. This form covers many areas including use of school internet, use of privately owned electronic devices on school networks and media parental consent form. Please <u>CLICK HERE</u> to access this Policy and Procedures form. **It is very important these forms are completed promptly.** Those students with incomplete forms will not be able to use electronic devices in class, access their google classroom, go on walking field trips, plus more. Google classroom is the platform teachers will use to communicate with their students and parents.

Personal Digital Device Expectations At West Vancouver Schools, we understand that personal digital devices offer students valuable opportunities to collaborate, create, and communicate, enhancing their learning experiences. We also recognize the importance of maintaining focused and safe learning environments for all students. Recently, provincial guidelines and legislation have further highlighted the need to minimize distractions, as digital devices can interrupt class time, interfere with student concentration, and disrupt the educational setting.

To support focused and safe learning environments, West Vancouver Schools is refining our approach to digital device use and will be uniformly applying personal digital device expectations across all schools. **Starting this school year**, **personal digital devices will only be allowed with the explicit permission of a teacher or administrator**, who will **provide clear guidelines to ensure their use is intentional and directly supports student learning.** Additionally, considerations will be made to accommodate students' medical and health needs, accessibility, and accommodation requirements.

Here's what this means for Westcot School:

• Elementary Schools: Personal digital device expectations will apply throughout the entire school day, including before school, after school, and during break times. Cell phones will not be used at all during school hours.

How You Can Help:

To support these updated expectations, we ask parents and guardians to:

- Familiarize Yourself: Please take the time to read through the <u>Parent/Guardian Guide to Personal Digital</u> <u>Devices</u> to fully understand the new district-wide expectations. Additionally, review any specific guidelines or expectations provided by your child's teacher(s).
- 2. **Model Appropriate Use:** Demonstrate and discuss the importance of limiting device use at home, especially during family time or other important activities. Your behavior sets a powerful example for your child.
- 3. **Encourage Balance:** Help your child find a healthy balance between screen time and other activities, such as reading, outdoor play, or family interactions. This will reinforce the focus on learning during school hours.
- 4. **Mindful Communication:** Please avoid calling or texting your child during school time. Remind your child that school time is for learning, and that messages can wait until after school. **If urgent communication is**

needed, please contact the school office at 604-981-1270.

By working together, we can create a safer, more focused learning environment for all students. These small steps at home can make a big difference in reinforcing the positive changes we're implementing at school. Thank you for your cooperation and support.

School Cash Online We are very excited to announce that our school will continue to offer School Cash Online, which provides you with the convenience of paying online for school items such as trips, club/athletic fees, and spirit wear. **If you registered in a previous school year you will not need to reregister.**

Please follow the link below to register online (it takes less than 5 minutes!). Once you have registered your child, you will be able to see when they have a new item posted online for purchase. You also have the option to be notified whenever your child has a new school expense due, so you don't have to worry about missing the deadline.
