make the Book Fair run so smoothly - Thank you! To Ms. Hunt and Ms. Brown -Thank you.









requires each school in our province to have a multi-year school plan (FESL) that outlines a goal focused upon improving student learning. The framework is to be evidence-informed and outline a clear action


