Please Call the Callback Line 604-981-1276. (Not the Office Please) before 8:00 am

As part of the Westcot safety program all students are accounted for each day as either absent or present. # Opening Day and Week for Grade 1 – 7 students

# September 2nd:

Please establish a meeting location offsite for your children to connect with you. Children directly supervised by an adult are welcome to play on the playground at the end of the day.

Students not in attendance by September 4th: Will not have a guaranteed spot at Westcot. Students must be present in class by September 4th at the latest to be registered.



# **Optional Accident Insurance for Families**

West Vancouver Schools reminds families each year that personal injury or accident costs are not covered by the district or its insurance provider. To help protect against expenses from accidental injury, unexpected medical costs, or critical illness, families have the option to purchase voluntary accident insurance plans. A variety of providers offer different levels of coverage, so families are encouraged to review their options carefully and choose a plan that best meets their needs.



#### **Medication at School**

#### Please remember you must:

Provide the medication in a container clearly labeled with child's name, medication name, dosage and medication's expiry date.

Theme: Healthy Spine, Healthy Life and Life Lessons from Nature
