As part of the Westcot safety program all students are accounted for each day as either absent or present. A Call Back program is in place to check on students who are absent if no contact with the school has been made. We will continue to carefully monitor all absences and ask that you use this central communication rather than or as well as emailing individual classroom teachers. Parents can help with the overall efficiency of this process by informing the school if your child is going to be absent.

When school staff return in September, changes to school enrolment often occur. Changes include new families registering and other families informing the school that they will no longer be returning. This often means that new class configurations and placements need to occur across all West Vancouver Schools. Learners at Westcot, as is the case for all West Vancouver students this fall, can expect to officially meet their new teacher(s) for the 2025-2026 school year on Thursday, September 4th.

Factors that Westcot considers for classroom configuration and placement include, but are not limited to:

- Unique individual and diverse needs
- · Learning styles, self-regulation and executive function strengths and challenges
- Ministry class size and composition requirements
- · Enrolment demands
- Social/emotional needs
- Past friendships and possibilities for new friendships, with a focus on what is best to support each child in ensuring their studies are positively impacted



Optional Accident Insurance for Families

West Vancouver Schools reminds families each year that personal injury or accident costs are not covered by the district or its insurance provider. To help protect against expenses from accidental injury, unexpected medical costs, or critical illness, families have the option to purchase voluntary accident insurance plans. A variety of providers offer different levels of coverage, so families are encouraged to review their options carefully and choose a plan that best meets their needs.



Medication at School

It is critical that you inform the school about serious medical conditions or allergies that may affect your child. For your child's safety, please don't assume we've already been told about your child's medical condition.



Please remember you must:

At the beginning of each school year (or when medication is to start), complete and return to the school a medication administration card signed by the physician. Cards are available from the school from Mrs. Satchell. Please contact her if you require a Medication form.






