- <u>Wednesday November 4 @8:30am: Cohort 11 & 5; Grade 11's only</u> Grade 11's in 1st period with Mr. Randall, Mr. Davidoff, Ms. Earland, Mr. Dodsworth, Mr. Dignum, Ms. Tustin

Students will be given an individual memo informing them of their exam date, location and time on Monday. Please avoid any planned absences November 2- 6th as all Grade 11 students should write this assessment in the November exam session.
