## 1. Grade 9 Immunizations on Thursday - October 15, 2020

Dear Parents/Guardians of Grade 9 Students:

Vancouver Coastal Health has scheduled the Grade 9 Immunizations Clinic at West Van Secondary on Thursday October 15<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 am. Consent forms have been mailed out to those students requiring a vaccination. Please complete with <u>YES</u> or <u>NO</u> for each vaccine. Please sign your child's consent form and return to the school office by Tuesday Oct 13<sup>th</sup>.

If your child is unable to attend the clinic on Oct 15<sup>th</sup>, please call 604-983-6863 to book an appointment with VCH immunization clinic.

If you are not planning to get your child's immunization at the school clinic please indicate this on the form to avoid receiving further follow-up notices. Forms need to be signed and returned to school regardless of whether you are having them done at school or not.

If the immunization record that we have for your child is incomplete please include a complete history when you return the consent form. Please discuss the information provided for the vaccines with your child and make your wishes known. While every effort is made to obtain consent from parent/guardian, a competent child may self-consent to health care as a mature minor in accordance to the BC <a href="Infants">Infants</a> <a href="Act.">Act.</a>

All WVSS Grade 11 students will be writing the Graduation Literacy Assessment (GLA 10) this November at West Vancouver Secondary school. This assessment is required for graduation purposes. *Please avoid any planned absences November 2- 6<sup>th</sup> as all Grade 11 students should write this assessment in the November exam session.* The exact exam schedule will be provided in the upcoming weeks.

Students should prepare for this exam. It is important that students try their best and take this assessment seriously.
