1. Quarter 1 Mid Term Report Cards - Tuesday, October 20, 2020

2. Reminder - Health and Safety Protocols (We Need Your Support)

Now that students have settled into their new school structure, we are asking for families to discuss and review a few of the important safety protocols.

General Protocols:

- Staff and students are required to perform a daily self-assessment for <u>symptoms of common cold, influenza, or COVID-19</u>. If any symptoms are present, those individuals are not permitted to enter the building under any circumstance and are encouraged to follow up with a medical appointment
- Upon entry to the building sanitize your hands
- Masks are required while moving about the hallways, or in spaces where physical distancing is not possible (outside of your cohort)
- While moving about in the hallways, stay to the right at all times
- Where possible, use physical distancing (2m) at all times
- Use designated entry and exits to gain access to the building
- Arrive no earlier that 5-10 minutes prior to the start of class and go directly to it
- Students are to leave the building and go home if they have a spare, or a hybrid class there is no lingering at school

Masks:

Masks must be worn at all times in hallways, stairwells, and common areas where students are outside of their cohort group, or physical distancing is not possible. At the time of this email, masks are not mandatory in the classroom but students should feel comfortable wearing them there if they so choose to.
