6. Graduation Numeracy Assessment: Grade 10 Students – January 25 - 28, 2021

All WVSS Grade 10 students will be writing the Graduation Numeracy Assessment (GNA 10) this January at West Vancouver Secondary school. This assessment is required for graduation purposes. *Please avoid any planned absences January 25-28 as all Grade 10 students should write this assessment in the January exam session*. The exact exam schedule will be provided after the holidays. **Students should prepare for this exam**. It is important that students try their best and take this assessment seriously. All grade 10 students should try the sample exams (printed or online) and review the scoring guide.

7. Graduation Literacy Assessment: Grade 11 Students – January 25 - 28, 2021

Any WVSS Grade 11 students who has NOT YET written the Graduation Literacy Assessment (GLA 10), will do so in January at WVSS. This assessment is required for graduation purposes. The exact exam schedule will be provided after the holidays. Ms. Tanfara will provide a memo to any grade 11 student who needs to write this assessment with all required details.
