1. Quarter Schedule Adjustments for Quarter 2, 3, and 4.

As we adapt to the new timetable we have been soliciting feedback from students, teachers and school leaders in order to refine our schedule to the Quarter System. To further support the successful transition between quarters, we are incorporating a *Quarter Turn Around Day* on the last day of each Quarter.

The purpose and intention of these days is to provide an opportunity for students to work with teachers to make up incomplete work, provides time for reassessment (assessment, review and completion) and creates time and space to reset and turn around for the next quarter.

Schools and teachers will communicate the learning opportunities provided and planned for their students on the *Quarter Turn Around Days*.

2. Graduation Numeracy Assessment: Grade 10 Students – January 25 - 28, 2021

All WVSS Grade 10 students will write the Graduation Numeracy Assessment the week of January 25-Jan 28^{th.} *Please avoid any planned absences that week.* Students will receive a memo this Friday or Monday indicating the exact date, location and time of their assessment. Their first period teacher will also provide students with these details. Grade 10 Students will be added to a google classroom next week in order to assist them with assessment preparation.

3. Graduation Literacy Assessment: Grade 11 Students – Thursday January 28, @ 8:30am Lab C233/C231

Any WVSS **Grade 11 students** who has NOT YET written the Graduation Literacy Assessment, and has a first period class, will write the exam on **Thursday January 28**th at **8:30 am in computer lab C233**. Those students **without a first period class will write Thursday January 28**th at **8:30 am in computer lab C231**. Students will receive a memo this Friday or Monday with all the details. This assessment is required for graduation purposes.
