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1. 2021-2022 Secondary Schedule Planning & Communication

We would like to thank all of our parents and guardians for participating in our Secondary Schedule Planning Surveys. We had very high levels of participation and will share the results in greater detail after Spring Break. The following points summarize some of the key findings and provide a current high-level overview of our Secondary schedule planning for the 2021-2022 School Year.

Current Context

- We are planning the 2021-2022 Secondary schedule with the understanding that we will still be in the COVID 19 pandemic.
- The 2021-2022 school year is a "Transitional Year"
- We do not know what the MOE/Health Guidelines will be for September 2021.
- The 2021-2022 Secondary schedule needs to be flexible and scalable between Stages 1 and 2 of the BC Restart Plan.
- We are anticipating 100% in-person instruction.

Takeaways from Stakeholder Survey

- Quarter System has been working in the context of the pandemic.
- Focusing on fewer courses at a time has been easier for students to manage.
- The hybrid experience, as provided this year, was less effective than in-person instruction.
- X Block is highly effective, and with refinement, has greater potential.
- A Semester schedule is viewed by all stakeholder groups to be the most effective schedule for student learning.

Next Steps

- We are beginning our planning around the Quarter System as it provides maximum flexibility.
- We are optimistic that guidelines will permit us to transition from our Quarter System planning to a Semester Schedule for the 2021-2022 School Year.
- Although we are not running a traditional linear schedule next year, there will be some linear course options available.
- Regardless of the schedule above, we will continue to have X Block to provide linear programing and student support.

2. Spring Break 2020: March 13 – March 28 & Easter weekend

This is a reminder to parents and students that the district two-week Spring Break begins this weekend Classes resume as usual on Monday March 29.

Easter Long weekend: Easter is a four-day long weekend this year with no classes on Friday April 2 to Tuesday April 6. Classes resume on Wednesday April 7, with our usual hybrid Wednesday. The staff of WVSS wish all students and their families a restful and enjoyable Spring Break!

5. Ministry of Education 2021 Student Learning Survey – Gr 10 & 12 Parents

The Student Learning Survey 2020/2021 is to be completed **by April 30th** http://www.bced.gov.bc.ca/sat_survey

The Provincial Student Learning Survey gathers information on topics related to school environment, safety, and achievement. The information is used for planning in individual schools and provides a district and provincial perspective. It will be administered to students in grades 10 and 12, their parents/guardians/caregivers, and all school staff. The surveys contain standard questions for the Province. It is simple and secure, and can be accessed by selecting the school district and school name

where your child attends school. Provincial, District and School Reports for previous years can be viewed at the same site under the Results section.
