## **1. Ministry of Education Affordability Funding**

The Ministry of Education has provided West Vancouver Schools \$650,000, a one-time funding for us to make the 22/23 school year more affordable for students and families in need. We have now received the funding for our 18 schools and have allocated the money based on the specific needs of each of our school communities. Our allocation:

- Will allow schools to cover costs for school fees, school supplies or other school related costs for students in need
- Some funds will be used to benefit large groups of both elementary and secondary students

Families are encouraged to reach out to their principal if any financial support is needed for school-based supplies, fees or activities.

## 2. Report cards and Family Portal Access

Parents will be able to access Student Report Cards on the MyEd family portal starting in the later afternoon on Thursday, November 17<sup>th</sup>. This report card will include Semester 1 Midterm Marks and Term 1 Marks for Linear classes. **Family Portal Important Notes:** Please be sure to logon to your MyEd Family Portal account so that you can access upcoming report cards and other published reports. This will ensure you will be able to see your child's report card when it is posted.
