#### 3. Graduates: Important Information to know!

**Graduation Diplomas**: Your Graduation Diplomas will be mailed to you in August. Please make sure you inform Ms. Kerr (<a href="ukerr@wvschools.ca">ukerr@wvschools.ca</a>) in the office if you need your diploma sent to a different mailing address than what is on file. Congrats Grads and stay in touch!

**Archiving Google Drive:** You Google Drives will disappear soon!! The easiest way to archive your Google Drive is to use something called <u>Google Takeout</u> or <u>Google Transfer</u>, which we have now enabled for people within the SD45 G Suite for Education domain.

**Final PSI Selections:** Final transcripts will be released by July 31. To ensure timely delivery to their selected PSIs, students should make their selections in the Student Transcripts Service (STS) by July 7. # 4. Next School Year and Opening Week Information

Prior to classes starting on Tuesday, September 5<sup>th</sup>, parents/guardians, and students can expect an e-bulletin outlining the opening schedule for school start up. This email will be sent the last week of August or September 1<sup>st</sup>. We are looking forward to meeting our newest, Grade 8 highlanders and seeing our returning students rested and ready for another great year!

**School Supplies:** Incoming students do not need to purchase any specific school supplies. Teachers will discuss any specific supplies needed the first week of school. We do recommend that students have their own laptop or Chromebook, 2 D Ring Binders, loose leaf papers, and pens and pencils.

#### 5. Headed Back to Linear – 2023-2024 Schedule

Next year we will be back in a <u>linear system</u> which means that all students will have 8 classes in their timetable that run all year. There will be 4 periods (classes) each day. Day 1 classes take place on one day and then Day 2 classes take place the following day.

<u>Academies</u> will take place either in the morning before school, during 1-4 and 2-4 (the afternoon classes/periods) or after school. Your academy will let you know.

There will be 50 mins of <u>Flexible Instructional Time (FIT)</u>. FIT will usually take place on **Mondays and Thursdays**. **FIT will be from 11:00 – 11:50 a.m.** and is replacing X-Block.
