- Grads arrive in Cap and Gown at 6pm
- Cap and Gowns are available for pickup at school on June 8 and 9
- Grads do not need to buy a ticket
- Tickets are unlimited and available on School Cash online
- Tickets can be picked up in Counselling office with School Cash Online receipt

This fee covers the cost of the student at the Orpheum, their cap and gown which they get to keep, as well as a few other graduation related items.
