Please complete the consent form with a YES or NO by each vaccine. We will be offering the following routine Grade 9 vaccines to students this year:

• Meningococcal vaccine: A 4-strain meningococcal vaccine will be provided that protects against strains A, C, Y and W-135.

- **Tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis (whooping cough) vaccine:** One dose boosts childhood immunity.
- Catch up vaccines: If needed for those missed at younger ages.
