If the immunization record that we have for your child is incomplete please include a complete history when you return the consent form or email to NorthShoreVaccineRecord@vch.ca

We will be offering the following routine Grade 9 vaccines to students this year:

- **Meningococcal vaccine:** A 4-strain meningococcal vaccine will be provided that protects against strains A, C, Y and W-135.
- Tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis (whooping cough) vaccine: One dose boosts childhood immunity.
- Catch up vaccines: If needed for those missed at younger ages.
