## 3. Traffic Congestion - arrive early and drop off further away

With construction well underway, there is an increase in traffic around WVSS. We are asking parents to help us by arriving earlier and dropping off students farther away from the school. We encourage students to use public transit, bike, or to walk to school to reduce traffic congestion and environmental impact. In addition, with darker days and rainy weather, student safety is paramount. Please remind students to use the marked crosswalks and look both ways. January 22-26<sup>th</sup>, grade 12 students will write the Literacy 12 Graduation Assessment.
