1. Upcoming Traffic Challenges effective Monday, January 15th, 2024

Effective Monday January 15th there will be a full road closure on 15th Street between Mathers Avenue and Queens Avenue. The closure will be from **Monday to Friday**, between 7:30am to 5:30pm. Please avoid driving on Mathers these days. A detour will be set up at Queens Avenue and Inglewood Avenue, connected by 21st Street.

Families will want to plan for:

- Selecting an alternate travel route
- Leaving at an earlier time
- Dropping off and picking up away from the school
- Avoiding Mathers Avenue
- No access to staff parking lots
- Speed limit of 30km/hour in school zones

January 15th to 17th

The full intersection at 15th Street and Mathers Avenue will be closed in all directions.

January 18th to 19th (and hopefully beyond)

Mathers Avenue, both east and west, will be open at 15th Street, as well as 15th Street south at Mathers Avenue.

Bus Route changes:

The #257 bus route up 15th Street will be eliminated for the duration of the project. The school and school District are currently working on exploring options to support our students and staff, and hope to have a response soon.

FAST is a young lifeguard education program that allows students to develop the essential skills to be successful and confident lifeguards. At the completion of the FAST program students will have obtained all the required certification prerequisites necessary to enroll in the National Lifeguard Course, which students can take independently when they are 15 years of age or older. Completion of the National Lifeguard Course is the final credential necessary to qualify an individual to work as a lifeguard.
