Total: 80 Credits (20 classes)





- Learning Support will fill an elective choice
- An extra elective is possible if CLE 10 or Sport Academy is outside of timetable

Elective Credits: Languages

- Language is <u>not</u> necessary for graduation
- Language 11 is required for UBC and SFU

Temporary Password Given:

- Log in with temporary password case sensitive
- Will need to <u>immediately</u> create a new password
- Password <u>must</u> meet security requirements

Example: Grad#2026

- Password can't contain any login info
- Password must be reset every 3 months

How to Enter Classes in MyEd

- 1. Log into My Education BC
- 2. Go to MY INFO tab in the left corner
- 3. Choose **REQUESTS** in left column
- 4. Input course selection
- 5. When finished select **POST** in bottom left corner
- 6. Hand in course selection sheet with **ALTERNATES** filled in
